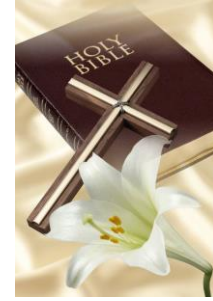

Wishing everyone all the best for the Festive Season and a happy and safe 2017

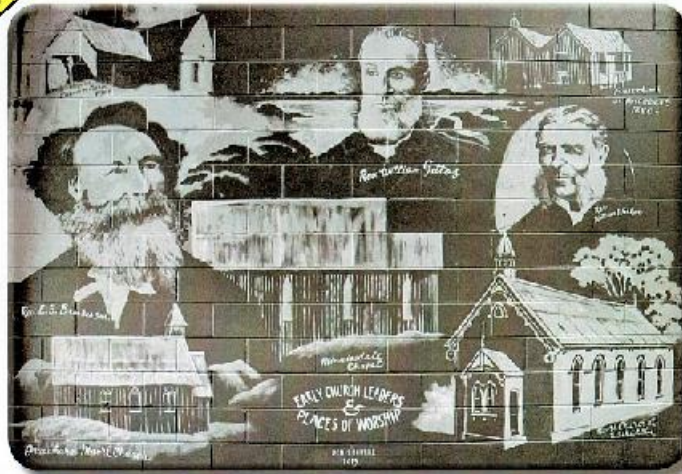
